Subject: Safety around crosswalks

Kumar,

I spoke to you last week about working on a proposal to present to the town council to help make the crosswalk on Aberdeen Dr. in Southern Village safer for students to cross on their way to Scroggs Elementary School. The Parent Advisory Council at Scroggs (which I am a member of) feels that adding no parking signs 50 feet on either side would be a good idea. Before I write the official proposal for you to present at the Jan. 9th town council meeting I wanted to confirm the information concerning the distance that no parking signs can be placed from a crosswalk. Is there a standard distance? Do you have any recommendations?

The group of parents and administration that are working on this issue meets Dec. 12th. I would like to run my proposal by them before sending it to you in final form.
