As per our discussion this afternoon we would like to request that the existing no parking ordinance be changed to no parking except by permit.

Although this has not been a problem in the past we are concerned that it may become an issue in the future.

We live at the corner of Sweeten Creek Road and Amesbury Drive and, due to limited space in our driveway; we park one car in the front of our house on Amesbury Drive. If you have visitors during the day, including children in local colleges that stop home during these restricted hours, it becomes necessary for them to park in the street.

The original intention of these signs was to discourage ECHHS students from parking in the street and to encourage them to follow the proper procedure and obtain a school parking permit.

In the past these signs in conjunction with friendly reminders have been very successful in eliminating the student parking problem.
