

SUMMARY OF HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION ACTION

Subject: Proposal to expand the Chapel Hill National Register Historic District

Boundary

Meeting Date: March 9, 2006

A citizens group approached the Commission with a proposal to expand the Chapel Hill National Register District to match the existing Franklin-Rosemary Local Historic District boundary. The group informed the Commission that a grant application, to assist in the creation of the expanded district, would have to come through a certified local

government.

The group was seeking support from the Historic District Commission and the Town in the execution and implementation of the proposed grant.

Recommendation: The Commission unanimously supports the applicants proposed to apply

for a grant in order to pursue expanding the boundary of the Chapel Hill National Register District into Franklin-Rosemary Local Historic District.
