Dear Mayor Foy:

On February 12, the Board of Commissioners received a presentation from Town staff on the proposed Bolin Creek Trail, Phase III Concept Plan.

As per Board discussion and subsequent conversation, we would like to share the following comments about the draft Concept Plan:

- The Board agrees that the most practical manner of extension is to begin at Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard (the current terminus) and move westward.
- Connectivity of this greenway with trails and open spaces to the north and west (Carrboro, County, UNC, Duke Forest) remains an area of primary importance.
- Additional specificity from UNC regarding the trail network within Carolina North (which this greenway and extensions thereof would link to) would be very helpful information and should be requested.

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comment on the draft concept plan. As a funding partner in this project, through the 2001 County Parks and Open Space bond, we look forward to the day when Bolin Creek Greenway will extend further west and connect with Carrboro and County trails and open space, furthering our mutual interest in open space connectivity.
