SUMMARY OF COMMUNITY DESIGN COMMISSION ACTION

- Subject: Application for Homestead Twin Towns Special Use Permit
- Meeting Date: April 18, 2007

Recommendation: That the Council approves the Special Use Permit for the Homestead Twin Towns development with the adoption of Resolution A (Attachment 3), as attached to the Staff Report dated April 18, 2007 with the following changes:

- 1. <u>Provision of Affordable Housing</u>: That the affordable housing stipulation for monthly condominium fees and utilities be amended to say that their Homeowner's Association dues are not to exceed 50% of the nonaffordable homeowner's dues.
- 2. <u>Homestead Road Improvements</u>: That the Homestead Road improvements be amended to delete the requirement for curb and gutter and substitute with a swale with maintenance responsibility by the Homeowner's Association.
- 3. <u>Energy Efficiency</u>: That the energy efficiency rating stipulation be amended to include a requirement that the energy models showing a minimum energy efficiency savings in accordance with current guidelines with a minimum of "Energy Star" rating for the buildings of 20% relative to ASHRAE standard.
- 4. <u>Stormwater Detention Facilities Responsibility</u>: Responsibility for maintenance of the stormwater facilities be the responsibility of the Homeowner's Association be added as a new stipulation.
- 5. <u>Curbside Refuse/Recycling Collection</u>: That instead of proving bulk refuse and recycling collection facilities, the proposed development may be served with curbside refuse/recycling collection and that the developer contract with a private refuse collection and/or recycling collection service for this purpose.
- 6. <u>Recycling Specialist</u>: That the stipulation requiring a recycling specialist be removed from Resolution A.
