## PETITION OF MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL BY KEVIN WOLFF REGARDING PROPOSED PUBLIC CAMPAIGN FINANCING PROGRAM FOR CHAPEL HILL ELECTIONS June 25, 2008

I, Kevin A. Wolff, hereby petition the Mayor and Town Council of Chapel Hill to:

- 1. Rescind the June 9, 2008 vote by the Mayor and Town Council approving the Proposed Public Campaign Financing Program and open the issue for public input and debate for at least three months, so that public opposition can be fully considered and comprehended in the proposal.
- 2. The Mayor and Town Council recuse (disqualify) themselves from approval of this proposal because of self-interest, bias and prejudice toward enactment of the proposal, and that the proposal be placed on the upcoming November, 2008 ballot. The town ordinances and state statutes clearly provide for such action when the Mayor and Town Council have a financial interest in the outcome of their decisions.
- 3. That a group of concerned and affected citizens, including myself, be appointed to work with the Council Committee on Voter Owned Elections to come up with a better proposal that is less biased in favor of incumbants.
- 4. That the State Legislature be requested to revise the enabling legislation so that the proposal may reduce or eliminate funding to incumbents.
