- Continue employee leadership development initiatives
- Explore and recommend methods for creating measurements of success for Council goals
- Explore and develop new administrative means for investigating and resolving serious incidents



#### Champion Downtown

- Implement Council approved parking study recommendations
- Plan for new Downtown Master Plan
- Complete and Implement Streetscape
  Master Plan
- Evaluate and implement new lighting standards downtown



### Continue Focus on Land Use, Transit, and Development

- Continue improvement of Development Review process
- Complete current planning processes under way
  - Revised tree ordinance
  - Inclusionary Zoning Ordinance
  - Historic Preservation Initiatives
  - New ordinances for transit and energy

- Complete current planning processes under way
  - Stormwater Management Program Master
    Plan
  - Rogers Road Report
  - Long Range Transit Plan
- Support the Sustainable Community Visioning Task Force (If approved)



## Continue Focus on Land Use, Transit, and Development

- Enhance sustainability efforts
  - Sustainable Operations and Services Team work plan and measurements
  - Emissions inventory



# Maintain & Improve Community Facilities and Services

- Begin the Library expansion project
  - Sell bonds Spring 2010
  - Begin construction Summer 2010
- Enhance focus on safety for employees
- Complete priority projects
  - Technology
  - Public art



# Maintain & Improve Community Facilities and Services

- Focus on ways to improve maintenance of current facilities
  - Landscaping "Town within a Park"
  - Parks and recreation facilities
- Begin planning for new public safety administrative and training facilities
- Evaluate and define community expectations of policing in Chapel Hill



# Improve Town's Fiscal Condition

- Develop a Recommended Budget based on a lowered tax rate calculated as revenue neutral, generating the same property tax revenue as 2008-09 from a higher tax base
- Enhance the non-residential tax base following the elements of the Economic Development Strategy



# Improve Town's Fiscal Condition

- Develop strategies for sustainability of the Town retiree health-care program including "other post employment benefits" (OPEB)
- Develop Debt Management Plan for the future investment in facilities to manage the Debt Service Fund created in 2008-09



# Plan Ahead for Carolina North

- Complete new Zone and Development Agreement by July 1, 2009
- Develop implementing agreements based on new zone and Development Agreement approved by Council and Trustees January 2010



- Council considers, modifies, agrees on Goals and actions steps for 2009
- Manager prepares a work plan as an agenda item for the Council approval – April 2009
  - The plan will include the agreements from the retreat on the 2009 goals



- Work plan considers:
  - Current work
  - Staff capacity
  - Budget
- Work Plan refines Goals with
  - Timelines
  - Measures of success



- The Council considers and approves the action plan April 2009
- Manager provides quarterly status reports on the work plan
