
Dear Mayor Kleinschmidt and Colleagues,

On behalf of the Community Dinner Committee I am asking you to support the Thirteenth Annual Community Dinner to be held in March 2011. The event, sponsored by the Cultural Arts Group, The Carrboro Branch Library, The Chapel Hill-Carrboro Chamber of Commerce, The Hillsborough Chamber of Commerce, The Preservation Society of Chapel Hill, Orange County Department of Human Rights and Relations and the Town of Carrboro is also supported by a large number of religious establishments, local community organizations and businesses and is testimony of the multicultural goodwill of a large segment of our very diverse community. At the 2009 Dinner held on March 1 at the Mc Dougle Schools, nearly seven hundred people of all ages and many cultural origins braved harsh weather to attend the event where they sat down together and enjoyed entertainment provided by several cultural groups.
