SUBJECT:	Update on Tree Ordinance Process
DATE:	February 2, 2010

PURPOSE

The purpose of this update is to provide a draft Tree Protection Ordinance to the Planning Board for their review and recommendation to the Council.

DISCUSSION

The Town hosted two public information meetings on this topic on October 26, 2009 and January 19, 2010. During each session, attendees asked about the draft language, process, goals of the ordinance, specific pieces of the language and the relationship between this effort and other goals of the Town. Town staff collected comments which generally fall into the following main categories:

- Difference in standards and penalties for residential versus nonresidential lots may be unfair (cost of replacement trees, level of detail required on applications)
- General opposition to additional regulation (homeowners and developers)
- Balancing tree protection with other environmental/community development goals may require some relief from stricter standards
- Use of mitigation funds needs to be clear
- Implementation/administration of proposed ordinance needs to be considered for applicants and staff
- Methodology for measuring canopy cover needs to be clear

The attached draft ordinance reflects the input received at both public meetings and via email.

NEXT STEPS

The attached draft Council memorandum outlines the main points of the ordinance. We are asking the Planning Board to make a recommendation to Council on the revised ordinance before the Public Hearing scheduled for February 22, 2010.

RECOMMENDATION

<u>Staff Preliminary Recommendation</u>: That the Planning Board recommend that the Council open the public hearing and receive comment regarding the proposed Tree Protection Ordinance text amendment.
