Draft Bicycle and Pedestrian Action Plan

Meeting Date:

August 17, 2004

Recommendation:

The Planning Board recommends the Council adopt the Draft Bicycle and Pedestrian Action Plan, with the following comments:

- The Board believes the pros and cons of the proposal to pave the Battle Branch trail should be studied carefully. The Board as a whole is conflicted on the issue, and agrees it is a sensitive issue. While paving of the trail would improve access for the public, it could also impact adversely a sensitive environmental area.
- The Board suggests adding more explanation of the process of choosing priorities and how the Plan would be implemented based on the Plan's goals and objectives.
- Land use, density, and destinations should be factors in setting priorities for implementation.
- Publicizing the advisory routes is a good idea.
