RE: PROPOSED ON-STREET PARKING REGULATIONS AND STRIPING OF BIKE LANES ON CAMERON AVENUE

Dear Resident:

The Town Council is considering installation of striped bike lanes on Cameron Avenue between Merritt Mill Road and Pittsboro Street. The Council, at its September 7, 2004 meeting, may consider enacting one of the following options:

- Option 1: Eliminate on-street parking on both sides of Cameron Avenue between Merritt Mill Road and Pittsboro Street and install striped bike lanes on both sides of the street.
- Option 2: Eliminate on-street parking on both sides of Cameron Avenue between 7:00am to 7:00pm, Monday through Friday, and install striped bike lanes on both sides of the street.
- Option 3: Maintain current on-street parking on both sides of Cameron Avenue and install parking meters and striped bike lanes adjacent to the parking spaces (by narrowing the travel lanes). Please see the attached sketch for reference.

We believe that any of the above changes could affect parking conditions on streets in the adjacent neighborhoods, and we would like to know your opinion about the proposed options.
