In 2004 we held our annual Harris Teeter Harvest Feast on October 3rd at the Raleigh Convention Center. We served a traditional holiday meal to 4,006 people. On November 26th, we fed 4,200 people in need in the Charlotte area.

We are very happy with the number of participants last year, however we know we barely scratched the surface of those struggling to make ends meet. Food Shuttle



The Harris Teeter Harvest Feast Food Drive is community building at its best," said Jill Bullard, Executive Director of Raleigh's Inter-Faith Food Shuttle. Jill Bullard and her team at the Inter-Faith Food Shuttle have been instrumental in making the Harris Teeter Harvest Feast a success.

Inter-Faith Food Shuttle, a United Way member agency, believes that hunger is unacceptable. They alleviate hunger by developing systems to recover, prepare and distribute wholesome, perishable food for the area's poor, hungry, undernourished and homeless.

Because you cared in 2004, Inter-Faith Food Shuttle accomplisments include:

- Rescued 4.2 million pounds of perishable food from over 200 donors including grocery stores, restaurants, and produce markets with 402,458 pounds coming from Harris Teeter.
- Provided over 26,000 grocery bags last year, directly to the doors of housebound & low-income seniors.
- Provided nutritious food to Community Learning Centers, Kids Cafes, and other tutoring programs for at-risk youth.
- Provide fresh, healthy food to 218 programs and agencies serving working families and others in need.
- Received \$1,107,228 from 1584 sources.
- Graduated 22 students from their Job Training Program.
- Prepared over 154,500 meals in our kitchen for those in need. Utilize 38,000 volunteer hours.

In the Triangle, over 11,735 senior citizens live below the poverty line according to US Census Bureau statistics. The cost of living is high in this community. There is an extreme shortage of affordable housing. Families with two wage earners making minimum wage cannot afford to pay rent and buy food. Since September 11, 2001, the Triangle has experienced major workplace layoffs climbing from a 2.2% unemployment rate to over 4.3% in early 2004. According to the 2005 Point In Time Survey, 1,106 people, including women and children are homeless in Wake County.
