Dear Ms. Summers,

I am writing to you in a desperate attempt to resolve an unhealthy and unsanitary situation in my Chapel Hill neighborhood.

For almost five years I have been in communication with the Town of Chapel Hill Inspections Department about the condition of the property owned by my next-door neighbor, Chin Ying Fan, at 720 Lea Court. Over the years Ms. Fan has collected rubbish and dumped it in her yard. There have been concerns filed about rodent and mosquito issues. Your office was also contacted in 2002 and I was given a brochure about rats.

I believe that this latest incident, however, warrants your attention.

Yesterday my husband and I were working in our yard and noticed a strong offensive odor coming from the direction of Ms. Fan's backyard. It seemed to be a decaying animal so we tried to find it to dispose of it. Upon closer inspection we found exposed buckets that are being used as an open sewer. The buckets contained urine and human feces. The area was littered with used toilet paper as well as decaying fruit, vegetables and bags of household refuse. My husband and I were stunned and sickened by the sight and odor. We called 911. Two police officers came to our house and answered our concerns by telling us that one hundred years ago all people defecated outside. They said that keeping buckets of human waste is not against the law. We still insisted that a police report be written.

I believe that keeping buckets of untreated human waste in this manner poses a health hazard to my family and the people in my neighborhood. I am hopeful that you can answer my growing concerns about this situation. Please advise me of the procedure to clean up this environmental hazard.
