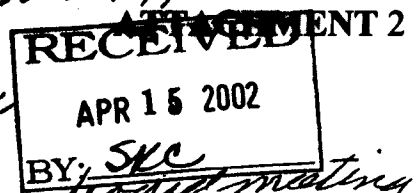

Dear Mayor Foy + Council Members,

At our last planning ~~board~~ meeting we renewed a special ^{use} permit application for the Europa building.

In May I voted not to give the owner a special use permit. April 2nd I voted for doing so. But late that night and ^{now} today I realized I made a mistake.

Although there is a new owner of this property, he or she should have realized at the time of purchase that the former owner had asked and received permission to build his hotel with more square footage than was permitted because he was leaving the rest of the land in low density use.

Therefore, this land should be kept to the density allowable under the law, without the special use permit being allowed.

I also noted ⁽²⁵⁾ against this project last Spring because of the concern of the many neighbors who will be impacted by the traffic and pollution caused by this project. Therefore, I felt their welfare and safety was a concern.

April 2nd I desiguarded their pleas because of a new traffic study that was made - but who knows if this study really does predict the future.
