We are pleased to inform you that your FY 2004 Capital Fund (CFP) and/or Replacement Housing Factor (RHF) has been approved. Attached is the approved Annual Statement and Annual Contributions Contract Amendment(s).

In reviewing the activities set forth in the Annual Statement, HUD has complied with the environmental requirements of 24 CFR Part 50. The activities set forth in the Annual Statement shall be undertaken in accordance with the requirements of HUD Notice PIH 2004-15. All PHAs receiving RHF funding should review, in detail, paragraph 19.
