**SUMMARY OF BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN
ADVISORY BOARD ACTION**

Subject: The Residences at Chapel Hill North - Application for Special Use Permit, including a Partial Revocation of the Chapel Hill North Phase I Special Use Permit (PIN 9880-36-1885)

Meeting Date: November 28, 2006

Recommendation: The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board recommends that the Council approve the application as set out in Resolution B of the Public Hearing memorandum except as follows:

Amend Stipulation 14 "Bicycle Parking" to allow subject to Town Manager approval, appropriate alternatives to inverted U- type racks for Class II bicycle parking.

Additional Stipulation "Provide bicycle and pedestrian connections between the northwestern most dwellings and the shopping center plaza which is located along the south side of the grocery store.
