Thank you for scheduling the March 7 work session on the Northwest Chapel Hill Small Area Plan. As a citizen who lives in this part of town, here are some suggestions that I would like to see evolve as development takes place.

1. Sidewalks and Bikelanes on: Homestead, Eubanks and Weaver Dairy Roads

2. A traffic study done projecting traffic from all developments as proposed even if in concept phase (includes arterial, collector and local roads with corresponding intersections in NW area)

3. Bus service on Homestead Road (from Seawell School Road and MLK Jr. Blvd.), Weaver Dairy Extension. and Perkins Drive.

- 4. A traffic signal at Homestead and Weaver Dairy Ext.
- 5. Some zoning for a daycare/preschool (to serve 0-3 year old children)
- 6. No increase in residential density beyond current zoning
- 7. No changes from commercial to residential zoning

8. Development on the comer of MLK Jr Blvd and Weaver Dairy that is fitting to the Northern gateway to Chapel Hill. e.g. buildings with architectural interest, tree buffers along the roads, public art, a grass area for public enjoyment.
