- Develop a Financial Plan




### CHAPEL HILL LONG RANGE TRANSIT PLAN ASSUMPTIONS

- Future Transit Service Will Expand Along Gateway Corridors and Throughout the Chapel Hill-Carrboro Service Area.
- Future Chapel Hill Transit Service Will Include a Mix of Local Bus Routes, Express Services and Higher Capacity Technologies Such as Bus Rapid Transit
- Expanded Regional Transit Services, Including Express Service and the Implementation of Regional Light Rail will Support the Chapel Hill Transit System.
