



Draft Ecological Assessment Composite Metric – Suitability Analysis Biohabitats, Inc., March 2007
























South Building

CAROLINA NORTH Early Council-Board of Trustee Discussions

- Scale of development covered by initial development agreement
 - How much development?
 - What length of time?
- Area to be rezoned
 - How much of property should be rezoned?
- Range and mix of uses permitted in the zone
 - What uses to be included in the first phase of development?

Parameters of Council-Board of Trustee Discussions

- Land included in proposed new zone
 - All Carolina North land within Chapel Hill jurisdiction
 - Approximately 643 acres
- Time period for proposed Development Agreement
 - Twenty years
- Amount of proposed development
 - Early phase: ~1.5 million ft²
 - Mid phase: ~3.0 million ft²
- · First projects: Innovation Center, Law School






