# AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE 2009–2010 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ENTITLEMENT GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE (2009-06-08/O-5)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statues of North Carolina, the following grant project is hereby established:

#### **SECTION I**

The projects authorized are the Community Development projects as approved by the Council on May 4, 2009: funds are as contained in the Funding Approval and Grant Agreement between the Town and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The projects are known more familiarly as the 2009 Entitlement Community Development Block Grant. The grant activities include renovation of public housing, property acquisition, community services to low-income residents, and administration costs for the program.

#### SECTION II

The Manager of the Town of Chapel Hill is hereby directed to proceed with the grant project within the terms of the grant document(s), the rules and regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, and the budget contained herein.
