AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PROJECT BUDGET FOR AN AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) GRANT (2009-06-22/O-3a)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following grant project ordinance is hereby adopted:

SECTION I

The project authorized is an ARRA Grant, through the Surface Transportation Program Direct Allocation (STPDA) program, awarded through an agreement with the Durham Chapel Hill Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (DCHC MPO). The project provides funds for transportation projects.

SECTION II

The Manager or his designee of the Town of Chapel Hill is hereby directed to proceed with the implementation of the project within the terms of the grant agreement executed with the North Carolina Department of Transportation and within the funds appropriated herein.

SECTION III

The following revenue is anticipated to be available to the Town to complete activities as outlined in the project application.
