#### **PROJECTS IN DESIGN:**

## 1. Herbarium Research Building (Botanical Garden) (36,000 SF) – \$7,044,000

#### (Funding – Appropriation Requested)

The Board of Trustees approved the design of this project at the May 1999 meeting. The 1997 Session of the General Assembly appropriated \$350,000 for advance planning for a Herbarium Research Building in the Botanical Garden. This planning is completed through Design Development. Construction of the project will depend upon future funding.

#### 2. Research Resource Facility - \$14,500,000

#### (Funding – University Non Appropriated)

The University has submitted a stimulus grant proposal to NIH for the next phase of expansion.

#### 3. Ackland Art Museum/Addition - \$20,000,000

#### (Funding - Gifts)

The planning is completed through Design Development. Construction will depend on successful fund raising.

#### 4. <u>Electrical System Improvements (South Substations) – \$3,000,000</u>

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated/Receipts)

Bids have been received and construction contract award is in progress.

#### 5. Morehead Planetarium/Science Center Addition and Rehabilitation – \$65,000,000

#### (Funding – Repair and Renovations, Appropriation requested and Gifts)

Construction documents have been submitted and project is waiting construction funding.

#### 6. Hinton James Renovation – \$37,500,000

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated/Receipts)

Project is currently on hold.

#### 7. Wilson Library Egress - \$1,425,032

#### (Funding – COPS Repair and Renovations)

Construction documents are in progress and scheduled for completion July, 2009. Project is waiting construction funding.

#### 8. <u>Davis Library HVAC Study - \$150,000</u>

#### (Funding – COPS Repair and Renovations)

Study is complete and project is waiting funding.

#### 9. Alumni Hall and Manning Hall Exterior Renovation Study - \$50,000

#### (Funding – Repair and Renovations)

Study is complete and project is waiting design funding.

#### 10. Smith Hall/Old Playmakers Theater Interior Renovation - \$4,000,000

#### (Funding – Repair and Renovations)

Construction documents have been submitted and project is waiting construction funding.

#### 11. Renaissance Computing Initiative (RENCI) - \$500,000

#### (Funding – State Appropriation)

Programming study is complete. Advance planning and construction will depend on future funding.

#### 12. South Columbia Road Improvements - \$1,400,000

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated)

Phase III improvements south of Health Sciences Library is scheduled for construction in summer, 2010.

#### 13. Med Air Facility - \$3,000,000

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated)

Construction documents are complete and project is waiting construction funding.

#### 14. Master Plan for DLAM Facilities - \$1,000,000

#### (Funding – Repair and Renovations)

Construction documents have been submitted for Phase I - Mary Ellen Jones Vivarium and estimated bid date is Summer, 2009.

#### 15. First School - \$1,600,000

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated)

Programming study is complete. Project on hold due to decision by Chapel Hill / Carrboro School Board.

#### 16. MacNider Hall Fourth Floor Renovation - \$3,500,000

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated)

Designer selected. Planning and construction will depend on future funding.

#### 17. Woollen Gym Life Safety and Fire Alarm Project - \$4,500,000

#### (Funding – Repair and Renovations)

Construction documents are complete and estimated bid date is July, 2009. This project has been added to the Carmichael Auditorium Addition and Renovation project.

# 18. <u>Student Recreation Center and Fetzer Gymnasium Roof Replacement - \$185,000</u> (Funding – Repair and Renovations)

Construction documents are complete and project is waiting construction funding.

# 19. <u>Knapp – Sanders Hall Second and Third Floor HVAC Replacement Study - \$600,000</u> (Funding – Repair and Renovations)

Construction documents are complete and project is waiting construction funding.

#### 20. School of Information and Library Science Planning Study - \$400,000

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated)

Programming Study is complete and project is waiting design funding.

#### 21. Wilson Hall and Coker Hall Sanitary Piping Replacement - \$350,000

#### (Funding – Repair and Renovations)

Project is on hold pending completion of Genome Science Building.

#### 22. Robertson Scholars Building - \$8,500,000

#### (Funding - Gifts)

The planning is complete through Design Development. The Robertson Scholars Program is developing this project.

#### 23. Kenan Stadium Renovation - \$50,000,000

#### (Funding - Gifts)

Kenan Stadium Expansion Phase II scope is being finalized. The Education Foundation is developing this project.

#### 24. <u>Innovation Center- \$20,000,000</u>

#### (Funding – Gifts)

Schematic Design is in progress. The Special Use Permit was approved and has been recorded. The project is currently on hold.

#### 25. Alternative/Renewable Energy Study - Phase I - \$5,300,000

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated/Receipts)

The Alternative Energy Study is finalizing recommendations and the University's Climate Action Plan report will be completed by September, 2009. The contract with Orange County is in place for the landfill gas power generation project. Design is underway for the collection system, pipeline and generator equipment. Estimated bid date is November, 2009.

#### 26. Stormwater Master Planning Study - Phase 1 - \$1,000,000

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated/Receipts)

Phase I will be complete by August, 2009.

#### 27. Renovations to Mary Ellen Jones Building - \$32,000,000

#### (Funding – University Non-Appropriated)

The University has submitted a stimulus grant proposal to NIH to fund the renovation to the 11<sup>th</sup>

#### 28. Medical Education Building - \$1,000.000

Programming study is complete and project is waiting design funding.

(Funding – State Appropriation)
