# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND ORDINANCE (2009-10-28/O-2)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the Affordable Housing Fund Ordinance to provide funds to purchase properties to create permanently affordable homeownership opportunities is hereby amended as follows:

### **SECTION I**

The Affordable Housing Fund Ordinance as authorized by the Town Council provides funds to purchase properties to create permanently affordable homeownership opportunities.

## **SECTION II**

The Manager of the Town of Chapel Hill is hereby directed to proceed with implementation of these projects within terms of funds appropriated here.

#### **SECTION III**

Revenues anticipated to be available to the Town are hereby amended by increasing Loan Repayments in the amount of \$136,000 as follows:
