The Glen Lennox Neighborhood remains, after 60 years, a cohesive, connected, culturally diverse area that is steeped in history. It is an iconic, integral part of Chapel Hill. The values that attract and sustain us as a unique Chapel Hill neighborhood, however, are being challenged. We seek to form a Neighborhood Conservation District (NCD), in partnership with each other and the Town of Chapel Hill, to preserve our rich character.
