AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PROJECT BUDGET FOR A TRANSIT GRANT (2009-10-28/O-6)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following grant project ordinance is hereby adopted:

SECTION I

The project authorized is a Transit Planning Grant, more specifically known as a Federal Highway Administration Section 104(f) grant, awarded through an agreement with the City of Durham. The project provides funds for transit planning activities.

SECTION II

The Manager or his designee of the Town of Chapel Hill is hereby directed to proceed with the implementation of the project within the terms of the grant agreement executed with the City of Durham and within the funds appropriated herein.
