(Denying the Special Use Permit Modification Application)

A RESOLUTION DENYING AN APPLICATION FOR A SPECIAL USE PERMIT MODIFICATION FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL #11 (FILE NO. 9788-18-1797) (2009-10-28/R-8c)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that it finds that the Elementary School #11 Special Use Permit Modification proposed by the Chapel Hill-Carrboro City Schools System, on property identified as Orange County Property Identifier Number 9788-18-1797, if developed according to the Site Plan, dated June 3, 2009, and the conditions listed below would not:

1. Be located, designed, and proposed to be operated so as to maintain or promote the public health, safety, and general welfare;
2. Comply with all required regulations and standards of the Land Use Management Ordinance;
3. Be located, designed, and operated so as to maintain or enhance the value of contiguous property; and
4. Conform with the general plans for the physical development of the Town as embodied in the Land Use Management Ordinance and in the Comprehensive Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Council finds:
