	Local govt submit Stage 1 Adaptive Mgmt programs to DWQ									
	DWQ reviews and, EMC approves or requires revisions to local program*									
	Implementation of local program must begin									
	Local govt must submit annual report									
	DWQ submits model Stage 2 Adaptive Mgmt program to EMC for approval									
NOTE: The Stage 2 Adaptive Mgmt Program will require 8% nitrogen and 5% phosphorus reductions										
	DWQ submits monitoring data report to EMC and every three years thereafter									
	If nutrient-related water quality standards are not being achieved based on monitoring data report, DWQ notifies local govts to develop Stage 2 Adaptive Mgmt Program									
	Local govt submits Stage 2 Program to DWQ									
	DWQ reviews and, EMC approves or requires revisions to local program*									
	Implementation of local Stage 2 program must begin; annual reporting continues									
NOTE: In 2023, additional modifications to the Stage 2 local program requiring 35% nitrogen reduction will be required if nutrient-related water quality standards are not being achieved										

* If the EMC requires revisions, local govt has two months to revise and resubmit and the implementation schedule is adjusted accordingly.

NOTE: The riparian buffer regulations for all projects conducted by local governments shall be administered by DWQ and are effective immediately (e.g., roads, utilities, and greenways that disturb the riparian buffer)

Fertilizer Management (15A NCAC 02B.0272)	After this date, application of nutrients shall be made by an applicator who has completed nutrient mgmt training or in accordance with nutrient mgmt plan that complies with this regulation									 
NOTE: This regulation is applicable to public recreational lands and road or utility rights-of-way
