- Subject:** Jordan Lake Rules Riparian Buffer Land Use Management Ordinance Text Amendment (LUMOTA)
- Meeting Date:** January 19, 2010
- Recommendation:** That the Council enacts the Ordinance as written, with the following additional recommendation:
- That the Council direct the staff to prepare a map, as soon as is reasonably practicable, using the best available stream data for submittal to the State for its review and approval.

- Issues Raised:**
- 1) Recognition that the 1977 Orange County Soils Map was not created for the purpose of mapping or protecting waterways, and lacks the level of accuracy and detail necessary for effective identification of streams to be protected; and
 - 2) That the Planning Board supports implementation of measures which would afford a high level of stream protection.
