First I must take issue with some assumptions stated by Sally Greene on her web site. She also quotes MLK to support her opinions. I use them to support mine. (Okay, scroll down to see my solution if you're short of time or more likely don't care about my opinions about Sally Greene's comments.)

Sally Greene quote-

"It takes nothing, away, I trust, from the rich beauty of what is found on the MLKs that currently weave through our nation's cities and towns to suggest that bringing this statement to the center of white Chapel Hill would be a step toward the racial unity that Dr. King longed for."

Again. Naming any road after anyone does absolutely nothing to bring two races together, <u>no matter where it</u> <u>weaves</u>. You can't unify races by naming streets after people. What world do you live in Sally?

MLK quote-

"Through violence you may murder a liar, but you can't establish truth."

My opinion-

King is proving my point. You can lead a horse to water, but you can't make him drink. Again. Naming any road after anyone does absolutely nothing to bring two races together.

Sally Greene quote-

"There's no reason why local men and women shouldn't have their own memorial (maybe right beside Silent Sam, a counter-memorial)".

My opinion-

Silent Sam is a monument to local men and women. You just weren't here when their sacrifice was important to the citizens of this town. It really doesn't matter which special interest group was supporting the statue then or why. I

look at it as a monument to my ancestors who were killed in the Civil War. You look at it as an outdated monument in support of slavery and mistreatment of African-Americans. This is exactly the way your proposal will "resonate" in the future. You want to rename the road to make a statement. So did the citizens who erected Silent Sam. "Future generations" will assign their own judgments about "signposts", not yours. You will not influence them to adopt your way of thinking about racial harmony by naming a road. Does the Silent Sam monument make you remember the Confederate soldiers the way the people who erected it wanted you to? Of course not. As a Texan,Sally Greene, perhaps you would support a monument to Mexican-Americans in front of the Alamo as a "counter-memorial."

MLK quote-

"The Western arrogance of feeling that it has everything to teach others and nothing to learn from them is not just."

My opinion-

This is exactly the way you are treating all the CH residents, not just those who oppose the name change. Ironically, one council member not acting with this arrogance is Edith Wiggins. Maybe a lifetime of living with injustices as a black woman has taught her something others have yet to learn. You are treating the 700 signatures that oppose your crusade like a bunch of insignificant racist republican slave owners. Changing the address of Town Hall does nothing to make them feel better.

Sally Greene quote-

Possibly, "Martin Luther King" signs would be, at most, signposts for a future generation--evidence of a road once

taken, but not taken seriously.

My opinion-

The MLK signs will only be looked at as a "me too", (not to mention "me too late") "signpost". To future generations it will be about as symbolic and memorable as another University Drive, University Road, University Boulevard or University Avenue. No one will be in awe that the road is a major artery to anywhere. People just don't do that.

<u>I think it is here that I can offer a solution</u>, although I don't believe you are open to alternatives. <u>Rename the airport</u> <u>Martin Luther King Jr. Airport</u>. Then when it is torn down, you can rename the road MLK Airport Road. Future generations will ponder, "You mean there was an airport here named for MLK? Wow, this must be a town that had it's act together in regards to racial unity!" That's the reaction you want to hear! That's the statement you are trying to make! This would also diffuse the objections to redoing stationery and the historical Airport thing. You would be able to phase in the idea slowly as stationery runs out. The history of the airport will be preserved. The NAACP will be more than pleased. And you will have shown extraordinary vision by pleasing both sides with a win-win solution.

Back to Sally Greene.

Sally Greene quote-

If for us Dr. King's beloved community was only a dream, at least let it be said that we shared it.

My opinion-

Renaming the road does not do this. No one is ever going to ride down that road and think, "Isn't this a nice thing for

white people to have done, name this road for MLK. They must have shared his dream to do such a thing. And how about that Sally Greene! Let's excuse her from all of our past and future judgments about racism."

One solution is to rename the airport first, then the road. How many airports are named after MLK? Even if it is destined to be torn down, the name MLK Airport Road will remain and elicit the discussion and resonance you seem to be seeking. Apologies to Horace Williams, but he was no MLK. Besides he already has a house and a tract. That's making a statement!

There was a right way to do this and so far you haven't done it. You could have listened to your community and found a compromise that we all could be proud of. But instead, many of you jumped off the cliff with the rest of the lemmings. Mayor Foy was right about more time given to the Apple Chill discussions than this issue.

I'm sure you are going to pass the name change regardless of what anyone other than the NAACP thinks.

We are stuck with it and the aftertaste of the process whether we like it or not.

We ask that the Council give serious consideration to, and pass the alternative proposal that Mayor Pro Tem Edith Wiggins presented to the Council Naming Committee on June 1, 2004, and reported to the community by our local newspapers.


War and Recovery Once More

A year before the guns of September 1939, war in Europe jarred Chapel Hill when UNC boxer Joseph O'Flaherty (class of 1937) died fighting for the Loyalists in Spain. In February 1941, Chapel Hillian John Yates Varley died of wounds in Inverness, Scotland, following a German air raid. After the United States entered the war, more than 20 Chapel Hillians would die in battle, many more in training accidents and from other causes.

In May 1940, UNC President Frank Porter Graham offered UNC to the department of defense—for any assignment. Four months later the war department okayed a \$154,835 grant that expanded the C.L. Martindale Airport into the Horace Williams Airport. In February 1942, the U.S. Navy established a Naval Pre-Flight Pilot Training School at UNC that trained 18,700 men, including future President Gerald Ford. On campus, the Navy built a hospital, a gym, an armory, a pool, and an officers' club as well as dozens of smaller structures. The Navy gave ships names familiar to Chapel Hillians—SS Cornelia P. Spencer, SS Horace Williams, SS David L. Swain, SS Elisha Mitchell, SS Kemp P. Battle, and the SS Byng Farrar, named for Alexander Patterson "Byng" Farrar, who died along with his 17-man crew when his Army tanker exploded on April 9, 1945.

The population of Chapel Hill streaked upward 251 percent between 1940 and 1950, to 9,177. When some 4,500 veterans enriched by the G.I. Bill arrived in the fall of 1946, hundreds had to live temporarily in tent encampments on campus, but the 1940s and 1950s *in toto* were joyous years, leading blindly into the wracking turmoil of the 1960s

Mayor and Members of the Town Council:

1. Please vote "Yes" to a Resolution along the lines of Options 2A and B outlined in the June 14 memo from the "Council Naming Committee."

2. Please vote "No" to Recommendations/Resolutions A, B, and D of the same committee regarding renaming Airport Road. I believe it would be destructive to Town unity to REname streets without overwhelming support from those directly affected, and you don't have that.

(The name of the "Council Naming Committee" should be the "Council Renaming Committee," if what you really want them to consider is REnaming streets.) There is a huge difference between naming a new street and renaming a street in which owners, residents, and business interests already have a stake, both psychologically and financially.

3. Why not concentrate on doing something positive that everyone can support, that will bring people together, and that will actually help those in the community that most need a leg up--on education, time and money management, for example? Changing the name of a street or streets does not change lives. Trips to the library can be enlightening, and the library is a good place to meet with a variety of helpers and volunteers as well. It's a place full of books, magazines, CDs, computers, community information, a quiet place to think, and the TV is off. It's free and is open to everyone in the Town.

4. If the Town were to respond to the NAACP's request with a well thought out response, such as dedicating NC Hwy86 as a Memorial to MLK, Jr., the ideas in Option 2 Part A sound wonderful. This plan would accomplish the goal of honoring King along the route, and would not be disruptive to people and businesses with Airport Road addresses (or MLK, Jr addresses either). But even better, is Option 2 Part B, because of it's educational thrust, and because it could likely draw more young people, in particular, into the library to learn about Dr. King's legacy and to learn about everything else too. In contrast to Resolutions A, B, and D, Options 2A and 2B both honor Dr. King, and at the same time set out to make some actual progress towards making his Dream come true.

Thanks again for your consideration and the hard work you do on the Council, building and maintaining the Chapel Hill/Carrboro community as an inclusive community.

My name is Melissa Johnson Lankford and I appreciate the opportunity to speak this evening.

I was mildly encouraged by Mayor Foy's memo that is being introduced this evening. It validates the primary concern of those opposed to the re-naming of Airport Road---the simple fact that no individual or business directly effected by this change has been consulted regarding impact to them and the feelings of history and pride citizens and others have in Airport Road. I am hopeful that the memo will be approved. And that a proper review and compromise will be reached by a cross-section of those **e**ffected and those desiring the renaming Airport Road will ensue.

First to recap: there have been 879 signers to the petition in opposition of renaming Airport Road for anyone or anything, there are now 157 additional signatures added to the 722. 744 have CH addresses, 63-Carrboro, 22-Hillsborough, 15-Durham, 10-Pittsboro and 25-Other; 144 signers had Airport Road addresses. Please bear in mind that of the 135 non-CH addresses the majority own property on Airport Road or as I, have a vested interest there through family or business. Are you aware this proposal has brought more comment to Town Hall than any other proposal since curbside garbage collection? Unnamed sources in Town Hall report more than the majority of phone calls have been against this proposal with hundred of calls received as well as the vast majority of letters to the Council, Mayor and Town Hall. The numbers just don't add up.

To date we have received rough cost analyses from 16 businesses that calculate the cost of this proposed change to Airport Rd totaling in excess of \$151,402 for the impact to business. This does not include the cost to residences or the larger businesses that must have all changes take place through a corporate office. Additionally there will be a very large cost to the Town of CH not just for new street signage but for the recommendation seeking to change the address of the Town Hall---this will be passed on to all taxpayers in CH, a double-whammy for those on Airport Road—clearly a demonstration of the Naming Committee's disregard for citizen input and pocketbooks. By reviewing these numbers, packets, and other documentation you have received; I hope you will see the REAL impact of this proposed change.

Second, I am still confused as to why those who are opposed to this renaming be required to offer up evidence that this is not a well thought out idea. As of yet, there have been no tangible reasons given for renaming Airport Road. It is preposterous to me and at least 879 others, that we who have had no voice continue to be required to justify keeping Airport Road as Airport Road. Some on the council have stated this is just like moving, but you are certainly wrong---we did not choose to make a move—we have been evicted—from Airport Road and this process!

Third, I was dismayed by the remarks of Cam Hill in yesterday's CH Newspaper—he stated that much opposition to changing the name of Airport Road is veiled racism—Mr. Hill this borders on slandering those who have exercised their right to participate in this so called process. Those of us in opposition to this proposed name change have solidly evidenced our position through comments, signed petitions, letters, emails, phone calls, attending meetings, and more— and we have been clear throughout, it is not Dr King we are opposed to, our opposition is to any name change at all.

In closing, I encourage you to receive and review the petition put forth by Charles Carver this evening.

I have since followed with interest the intense debate on this issue, and now encourage you NOT to rename Airport Road for other reasons.

First, the anger and divisiveness that have arisen are counter to the message of Dr. King. This aspect alone should encourage a solution supported by all citizens.

Second, I feel that some on the Council have adopted a regrettable stance of "we have decided what is best" ... and the road will be renamed -- without adequate exploration of options supported by thoughtful and concerned citizens.

Dr. King was truly one of the greatest civic leaders of the twentieth century. Few civic tributes to his memory can do justice to the societal change his life and good works inspired.

But no tribute to him can be more demeaning or insulting than to name or re-name a local street for him. A street?! For Heaven's Sake! The proposal is a put-down that might more appropriately have originated with individuals whose purpose is to discredit King and his good works, rather than to memorialize them.
