

**SUMMARY OF BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN
ADVISORY BOARD ACTION**

Subject: Rusch Hollow – Special Use Permit Modification.

Meeting Date: August 26, 2003

Recommendation: The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board recommends that the Council approve Resolution A, with the following stipulation:

- The proposed sidewalk along Rogers Road should be located in the public right of way. (see comment for explanation)

Comments: It is not clear if the proposed sidewalk along Rogers Road is to be located in the public right of way or in the landscape buffer. For future connectivity, the Board considers that the sidewalk should be in the right of way unless there are good reasons to the contrary.

All parking spaces to be provided should be sufficiently sized and sited to ensure that parking does not overhang the sidewalk.
