

**SUMMARY OF BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN
ADVISORY BOARD ACTION**

Subject: Red Hot and Blue at Village Plaza Shopping Center – Special Use Permit Modification

Recommendation: The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board recommends that the Council approve the Special Use Permit Modification.

Comments: The Board would like the owners of the Ginn parcel to consider modernizing existing bicycle parking facilities at the Ginn parcel to meet the Class II specification set out in The Town's Design Manual as amended 11th October, 2000:

"Class II is a stationary rack to which a bicycle can be secured with the user supplying both the lock and cable or chain. Racks must be easily usable with both U-locks and cable locks. Example is inverted 'U' rack. Racks that support a bicycle primarily by a wheel only and not the frame, such as typical "dish racks," are damaging to wheels and are not acceptable."
