Dear Ms. Smith,

We, the residents of Colony Woods Drive, are petitioning the town council for speed humps (bumps) to be placed at various locations on our street. We are petitioning the Council for said traffic control devices because we fear for the safety of our residents and pedestrians.

On a daily basis we observe vehicles traveling at excessive rates of speed, perhaps traveling as fast as 40 mph, through our neighborhood. As you are no doubt aware, the posted speed limit in this area is 25 mph. The residents of this peaceful neighborhood frequently walk along the streets for exercise, and are frequently walking with small children or infants and/or dogs. Additionally, a number of Senior citizens also live and walk in the area. The majority of homes in this area have only single car driveways, and unfortunately, many cars are parked on the street. Consequently, it is very plausible that a small child could run into the street unaware of a speeding auto, with tragic results.

Given the relative lack of closely spaced side roads, stop signs are infrequent. This, combined with a fairly long and open stretch of straight road, allows for drivers to perhaps unwittingly increase their 'unopposed' rate of speed.

It is through communications with the Chapel Hill Police department and Mr. Kumaar Neppalli, that we petition you for the installation of speed humps (bumps) to help ensure the safety of adults and children alike in our neighborhood.
