RE: PROPOSED ON-STREET PARKING REGULATIONS FOR LONGVIEW STREET

Dear Resident:

In response to a request by the WoodGlen Homeowners' Association, the Town was asked to evaluate the current on-street parking conditions along Longview Street between North Columbia Street and Airport Road. Under current parking regulations, parking on north side of the Longview Street is prohibited. Vehicles are permitted to park on south side of the street, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Our field observations indicate that parked cars occasionally block the driveway to the WoodGlen Apartments and restrict sight lines at this driveway and at the intersection of Longview Street and North Columbia Street.

We believe that parking regulations on Longview Street could improve these conditions. We are proposing changing the current parking regulations to "no parking anytime" on the south side of Longview Street from Airport Road to a point 560 feet west of Airport Road, as shown on the attached map.

As part of our evaluation, we would like to know your opinion about the proposed change.
