RE: PROPOSED ON-STREET PARKING REGULATIONS FOR PARKRIDGE AVENUE

Dear Resident:

In response to a request from several neighborhood residents, the Town was asked to evaluate the current on-street parking conditions along Parkridge Avenue near Soccer Field. Under the existing conditions, vehicles are permitted to park on both sides of the street.

The complaint is that during the soccer game, cars parking on both sides of the street reducing the available width of the travel lanes thus creating congestion and traffic hazard conditions.

As a part of our evaluation, we would like to know your opinion about the proposed change.
