

SUMMARY OF TRANSPORTATION BOARD ACTION

**Subject:** Southern Orange County Senior Center-Application for Special Use Permit Modification

**Meeting Date:** June 8, 2005

**Recommendation:** The Transportation Board voted 9-0 to recommend Council adoption of Resolution A with the following modifications:

- Stipulation 5, requiring a cross walk at the Homestead Park entrance be removed.
- The bicycle parking should be moved to the plaza at the northern entrance of the facility.
- The applicant should construct the section of missing sidewalk, east of this site, along Homestead Road.

They voted 9-0 to adopt the following additional recommendation:

- The Council should form a committee, made up of property owners along Homestead Road, between Martin Luther King Blvd and High School Road to review the issue of transit service along the Homestead Road corridor. This committee, which would include representatives from the Town and Orange County, would also provide recommendations on pedestrian and bicycle improvements.
