

**SUMMARY OF BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN
ADVISORY BOARD ACTION**

Subject: Northside Neighborhood Mobility Report

Meeting Date: March 22, 2005

The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board makes the following recommendations by consensus:

The Board gives general support to the report and the 3 highest priority improvements identified:

- Improved lighting,
- Additional sidewalks and crosswalks, and repair of existing sidewalks,
- Improved security

The Board considers that where eligible Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds should be used to tackle the recommendations of the report.

During the preparation of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Action Plan the workgroup deferred consideration of this neighborhood pending the recommendations of this report. The Board considers that the additional sidewalks recommended for construction should be considered in the context of all the priority sidewalks identified in The Bicycle and Pedestrian Action Plan. (i.e., they should be assessed with the Town's sidewalk ranking system and added to the sidewalk priority list).
