RE: PROPOSED ON-STREET PARKING REGULATIONS IN COLUMBIA PLACE NEIGHBORHOOD

Dear Resident:

In response to a petition by the Columbia Place Homeowners' Association, the Town was asked to conduct a survey of the on-street parking conditions for Columbia Place neighborhood. Under current parking regulations, vehicles are permitted to park only by residential parking permit on both sides of the streets in the Columbia Place neighborhood. We are considering prohibiting on-street parking on one side of Columbia Place East, Columbia Place West, and Columbia Place Drive and continue to allow parking by residential permit on the opposite side of each street. Please see the area map on the other side of this letter.

As part of our evaluation, we would like to know your opinion about the proposed change.
