Dear Ms. Barnes:

In the past, the Grandma's Support Group programs have been funded by donations and small grants from the CH/Carrboro City School Blue Ribbon Task Force, the Carrboro Human Relations Commission, and Dr. and Mrs. Randall T. Curnow.

This group's objective goal is to create "Unity" in the Pine Knolls Community, and to bridge the Generation Gap between Senior Citizens, Middle Age Adults, Young Adults, and Children. We want to better prepare our children to meet the academic requirements of the public school systems, enabling them to rise and meet the challenges that they face on a daily basis. As a result, they will feel inspired to stay in school and work toward high academic achievements, attend and successfully graduate from highly accredited colleges and/or universities, and subsequently return to this community to give back what has been given to them. Also, the community and neighborhood which they grew up in.

We are requesting a grant from the Chapel Hill Town Council of \$33,200. We ask that \$31,200 be an annual grant to cover the salaries of staff members at six hundred dollars (\$600.00) per week (the \$600.00 will be divided up to pay three staff members \$200 a week); one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) to provide camp activities from the period of June 10, 2002 through August 16, 2002; the other one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) will assist in the expense of estimated utilities for this same time period.

This funding will allow us to have year-round paid staff to direct activities including sewing classes for all age groups, health awareness, computer technology, tutoring, arts and crafts, self-esteem and communication workshops to name a few. If it is not possible to receive the requested amount, we hope that you will at least provide us with enough funding to have our summer program. This will include staff salaries, activities, and utilities.
