RE: PROPOSED ON-STREET PARKING REGULATION FOR CARVER STREET

Dear Resident:

In response to a request by a local resident, the Town has evaluated the current on-street parking conditions along Carver Street. Under current parking regulations, vehicles are permitted to park on both sides of the street, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Cars often park along both sides of the street in this area, reducing the width of the travel lanes and restricting the sight distance at some driveways. We believe that parking regulations on Carver Street could improve these conditions, and we are proposing "no parking anytime" on west side and "No Parking, Except by Residential Permit" at all times on east side.

As part of our evaluation, we are interested in your opinion about the proposed change.
