RE: PROPOSED ON-STREET PARKING REGULATION FOR MASON STREET

Dear Resident:

In response to a request from a local resident, the Town recently evaluated the current on-street parking conditions along Mason Street. Under current parking regulations, vehicles are permitted to park on both sides of the street, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Cars often park along both sides of the street in this area, reducing the width of the travel lanes and restricting the sight distance at some driveways. We believe that parking regulations on Mason Street could improve these conditions, and we are proposing "no parking anytime" on one side of the street.

As part of our evaluation, we would like to know your opinion about the proposed change.
