1. Ticks

This has been a bad year for the mini ticks from deer. I believe that there are too many. With one tick bite I do not feel safe, therefore I am forced to spray. I do not like the idea of the need to spray so often.

2. New building at Rosemary Street and Mitchell Lane concerns:

- a. Safety is the most important issue. Consider lowering the speed limit from Breadman's to Carrboro down from 35 mph to 20/25 mph. Speed limit should be lowered as it is on Franklin Street.
- b. Visible crosswalks necessary by completion of new project before on Rosemary Street.
- c. There not a sidewalk from Tate Realty to Breadman's.
- d. How many people will live in this building and work in this area, 200 or more?
- e. Where will the children play when Hargrave's Center is not open? One child has been hit crossing Rosemary and died about two weeks later. Please make it as safe as possible for the children who frequent Hargraves as on field trips. Will there be a play area off of the street and sidewalks for the children? Signs should be posted for the children's safety.
- f. From 4:30 to 6:00pm traffic is heavy. It takes 5-8 minutes at

a time to enter Rosemary from Mama Dip's parking lot and almost to make a right turn out of our restaurant instead of trying to cross over Rosemary. My customer's remind me of this constantly.

- g. On weekdays approximately 50 cars enter and leave Mama Dip's and on weekends approximately 100-125 or more frequent the restaurant.
- h. Lease agreement should be strict for business and residential to prevent loitering on the street and the street corners; additional parking problems. I am concerned about these issues due to those respecting existing businesses.

I have been on Rosemary Street for 26 years with many problems because of harassment to me and my employee's which has been unwarranted.

I hate the thought of having to move Mama Dip's to another county.
