On January 15, 2003 the Parks and Recreation Commission discussed the various petitions presented to the Town Council concerning the idea of making the Southern Community Park site available for a southern high school. The Commission noted that the park site was crucial if the Town intends to meet the goals established in the 2002 Parks and Recreation Master Plan.

The Commission voted 7-0, with 2 abstentions (Peter Schwartz and Terri Tyson) to recommend that the Council retain the site for park purposes. Ms. Tyson reported that she abstained because of her potentially conflicting role with the PTA. Mr. Schwartz reported that he is unsure of his position on this issue at this time.
