

Dear Mayor Foy and Council members,

On behalf of the Community Dinner Committee, I would like to remind you of our letter to you in early January 2003 asking to be considered in the Town's 2004 budget. As you will remember, we requested that the Seventh Annual Community Dinner celebrating cultural diversity to be held on Sunday, February 8, 2004 be considered for a performance agreement of \$500 (as was usual in the years preceding 2003- last year you rejected our request). The Dinner is a major community building exercise and having the Town of Chapel Hill listed as a sponsor acknowledges the efforts of its citizens in what has become a model project for other communities. You will be interested to know that Orange County, through the Department of Human Rights and Relations, has offered to become our fiscal agent thus preserving our non-profit status.
