1871. The Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment.  
 May 13<sup>th</sup> J. M. Kirkland absent.  
 On motion it was ordered that the Clerks office be dispensed with; and that the duties of the same be confided to the Board of Commissioners.  
 Ordered that the account of Young Evans of three dollars for 1867 & 1868, be allowed.  
 Ordered that there be a tax of forty (40) cents levied on the poll, and one tenth of one per cent on real estate.  
 On motion it was ordered that those <sup>who</sup> superintend the thoroughfare of streets be allowed seventy five cents per diem for their services.  
 On motion adjourned to meet on Saturday night the 20<sup>th</sup> of May 1871.

May 22<sup>nd</sup> 1871.

Ordered that Clerks Office be restored & that the clerk be paid (50) fifty cents for every meeting's service, when he is actually employed, & in case the Clerk fail to attend any one who performs the duties of the Clerk, shall receive the Clerks pay.

Ordered that the 8<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> Sections of the Laws passed by the Board of Commissioners of Chapel Hill for the better regulation & order of the Village, be stricken out - (See pages 42) + 43) + 60

Ordered, that the account held by Robt. Taylor (Col) against the billages of Chapel Hill not be allowed.

The Board of Commissioners met by Call of Mayor at 8 o'clock.

June 17<sup>th</sup> 1871.

Ordered, that Harrison Woodson be paid (75) Seventy cents, for work done on Street. (one day)

Ordered, that J. R. Clements be paid (\$1.50) one dollar & fifty cents, for two days work, on Street.
