A report was received from the Committee appointed to examine the streets leading from College Avenue, in the direction of Purifoy Mills, recommending that nothing be done at present.

On motion it was ordered that the Clerk make up and publish for twenty days the names of all delinquent tax-payers for the year 1873 - giving due notice that in case of failure to make payment within the time specified, collection would be made in accordance with Law.

On motion a committee of two consisting of J. M. Alexander and W. J. Newton, was appointed to examine the public wells, and report what repairs are necessary, also to examine the streets, and contract for such work as may be necessary.

An account was presented in favor of John McDowell, claiming \$5.²⁵ for Police duty and work done on the streets & public wells, and after some consideration it was agreed that he be allowed two dollars and seventy five cents on said account.

An account in favor of J. M. Barber claiming one hundred and thirty one dollar and fifteen cents for work done on the streets, was reported from a committee appointed to audit said account, and on the recommendation of the Committee said account was allowed and ordered to be paid.

There being no further business the Board adjourned to meet on the evening of the 26th inst.
