Board met at 12 o'clock P.M. at the Office of

The meeting was called for the purpose of receiving
bids on contract for letting Out a Culvert
near the Caulfield Store. The Contract was
awarded to William Green for the sum of 1200
Specification on said Contract was as follows.

Culvert to be cleaned out well from Side walk to
Side walk. walls to be built up if fallen in rocks
Covered up.

The contract to clean the grass off Columbia St.
from ditch to ditch, from Robertson and Harris
Drug Store to College Gate.
The grass to be cleared off Franklin St. from
ditch to ditch, from Robertson & Harris Drug Store
to the College Corner. The two above named contracts
was bid off by S. M. Marbee Jr. for the sum of
\$990 Nine Dollars and ninety Cents.

The Committee appointed to select a suitable room
for the board to meet in failed to make any report.
The Committee appointed to select a place in the
corporate limits for the purpose of building a
Guard house also failed to make any report.
after a lengthy discussion, on the breaking
open the house of Mrs. M. S. Hendon, the board
of Comt. of Chapel Hill inc. offered a reward of
300.00 Three hundred Dollars, to any person that
will furnish sufficient evidence to detect and con-
vict the person or persons who broke into the house
of Mrs. M. S. Hendon Saturday night June 13th
1878.

On motion of G. J. Winston the following
Resolution was adopted, that all persons shall be fined
100 One Dollar for Yelling, Howling, Singing, or
Shouting, Drunkenness on the Streets of Chapel Hill
after Sundown.

On motion it was ordered that the Mayor Appoint
two policemen, until further orders from the board.
On motion it was also ordered that a Committee of three
be appointed in policing the Town and report at
the next meeting of the board.

the Committee appointed
was S. M. Marbee Jr., J. M. Mason, G. J. Winston, and
J. H. Wilson.

There being no further business on motion
the board adjourned to meet at the store house of
A. G. Marbee at 8 o'clock, and hold a conference meeting.
