July 2nd 1900

Board of Aldermen met. Mayors office.
At 8 O'clock P.M. Mayor Barbee presiding.
Present Aldermen Pickard, Klutz & Holmes
P.L. La Cour stated to the Board that
the American missionary association
(Dr. A.F. Beard, Box 40 Madison Square, N.Y. City.)
would soon close out its work here and would
be willing to sell its property to the town at
a reasonable price. Moved and seconded that
the Aldermen appoint a committee of three
to write Dr. A.F. Beard in regards to the sale of
this property. The mayor appointed Messrs
Holmes, Klutz and Pickard.

Dr. C.S. Mangum Chairman of the Health
committee made a verbal report recommending
a thorough cleaning of the town.
Moved and seconded that the street committee
be authorized to have the drawor branches
running from Mrs Jane Guthrie, Mrs Joa Long,
Mrs S.M. Harris & Others owning property bordering
on said ditches, cleaned out and kept clean
all the year, at the expense of the owners of
property bordering these ditches, and sprinkle
lime in the ditches and on the soil removed
from the ditches in each case, also at the
expense of the property owner.

There being no further business the Board
on motion adjourned
