

Chapel Hill N.C.

According to adjournment the Board of Aldermen met at 8 o'clock P.M. Mayor MacRae presiding. Present A. A. Klutzy, Prof J. A. Holmes, W. S. Roberson and John Ward. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. The finance Committee made its report. Moved and seconded that the following resolution be adopted. Motion Carried.

i That the following taxes are hereby levied for the year of nineteen hundred and two:

Avalorum tax of forty cents on every one hundred dollars value of real and personal property as enumerated in section fifty, schedule A-1 of the Charter of the town of Chapel Hill; and on each taxable poll in the town of Chapel Hill as provided in section fifty, schedule A-11 in the said Charter, of one dollar and twenty cents.

ii On motion it was agreed,

That it is the judgement of the Board of Aldermen that out of the receipts from the taxes for the year 1902 at least one half of the outstanding debts of the town should be paid; and the finance Committee of the Board is hereby requested to arrange to do this. On motion the following bills were allowed and ordered paid.

Prof J. A. Holmes \$16.00 for feeding town mules  
W. A. Fritchard \$1.40 Where being no further business on motion the Board adjourned
