Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. Cemetery Committee reported that they had agreed on the price of burial lots \$5.00 each.

Moved and seconded that the report of the Committee be adopted. Motion carried.

The street Committee made a verbal report about the work on the streets.

A petition from Richard & Neville together with plans for erecting an owing in front of their store was submitted to the Building Committee and after being approved by the committee it was moved and seconded that the petition be granted. Motion carried. The erection of the owing be subjected to the street committee approval.

Moved and seconded that S.L. Herndon be required to repair his owing or take it down. Motion carried. And the Mayor ordered Mr O'Daniel to notify Mr Herndon. After being approved by the finance Committee the following bill were allowed and ordered paid.
