Board of Aldermen met at 8 O'clock P.M.

 and W.W. Dickard. Minutes of the last meeting were
 read and approved. Moved and sec. that the house
 & Premises ^{now occupied by} of Mrs Mariah Strain & A. R. Burrough Family
 be declared quarantine owing to ^{disease} ~~the~~ ^{present} Contag-
 disease. Motion carried.

Moved and seconded that any person who shall,
 without written permission from a Health Officer of
 the Town, leave any quarantine premises or district shall
 be subject to a fine of \$5.00 for each offence.

Motion carried. The following bills were read and approved
 and on motion were ordered paid.*

Call meeting of Board of Aldermen at 8 O'clock P.M.
 The following Aldermen were present S.W. Andrews,
 J.C. MacRae Jr., D. McCauley and W.W. Dickard,
 Mayor W.S. Roberson presiding. The Mayor stated on
 the advice of Dr Mangum, Chairman of the Board of
 health, that the quarantine against Mrs Strain's
 residence could be raised. On motion the quarantine
 was declared removed. Moved and seconded that the
 following be ^{ordinance} passed. Whereas the case of small pox
 on the premises of Mrs Strain on Rosemary street in this
 town have been pronounced convalescent, and as a
 precaution against the spread of the disease all persons
 residing within one hundred yards of or who had
 visited, the infected premises have been vaccinated
 under ordinance of the town. Now as a further
 precaution and under the advice of the Health Committee,
 it is ordained: that no person shall visit, the said
 premises without first having been vaccinated within
 the past five years, or without having obtained the
 written consent to visit said premises, from a member
 of the health committee of this town. Any person
 violating this Ordinance shall forfeit and pay
 five dollars for every such violation.

This Ordinance shall be in force for the space
 of One month from and after this date. Motion Carried.
 Moved and seconded that the secretary and treasurer be
 instructed to make out statement of the cost of the
 present case of small pox. Motion Carried.

Alderman G.W. Andrews offered his resignation
 which was accepted.

Moved and seconded that the action of the Mayor
 in ordering fine hose &c. be ratified. Motion Carried.
 On Motion the Board adjourned.
